TRASH COLLECTION INFORMATION



FOLLOWING THESE TIPS WILL HELP PREVENT A DISRUPTION OF YOUR REFUSE SERVICES.

- Have your bin out by 7:00 a.m.
- Bag your trash.
- Never over-fill the bin. Boards or boxes sticking out of the bin will prevent us from emptying the bin.
- Make sure the lid is closed.
- Don't force large items into the bin. This prevents the bin from being completely emptied.
- Do not place extra trash on top of or next to the bin.
- Make sure the bin is at least 4 feet from vehicles, fences, and mailboxes. Basketball hoops may prohibit us from being able to empty your bin. Please make sure basketball hoops are off the street and sidewalk when not in use.

- Never place ashes in the bin.
- Hazardous materials are not allowed in your bin. Oil, fuel, paint, tires, chemicals, propane/helium tanks, ammunition, batteries, hypodermic needles, prescription medication, fluorescent and CFL light bulbs, and ink cartridges all need to be taken to a proper disposal site.
