



FORT HUACHUCA WATERING POLICY AND SCHEDULE

Attended hand-held hoses to water newly-seeded lawns, trees, shrubs, gardens and flowers may be used throughout the year at any time.

Sprinklers and soaker hoses for yard irrigation may be used twice a week during the months of April, May, June, September and October only as outlined below:

Bonnie Blink: Wednesdays and Sundays from 1600 to 0900 next day

All other housing areas: Tuesdays and Saturdays from 1600 to 0900 next day

Watering is prohibited anytime between 0900 and 1600, and in the months of November through March, July and August.

Timers may be used to activate sprinklers only within authorized hours on authorized days. Timers must be shut off when there is sufficient rainfall to meet the lawn's water requirements. Sprinklers may not be operated so as to cause ponding of water or runoff from the yard.

Residents must provide sufficient watering with hand-held hoses to maintain the health of trees and shrubs in their yards, however, care must be taken to prevent water from running on to pavement or into the street. Plant watering guidelines are available at:
