- a. IAW Army Regulation 420-1, dated Nov 07, assignment to on-post family housing will not be made unless the Service Member is expected to occupy the housing for a minimum of six months.
- b. IAW TRADOC Regulation 350-6, dated 30 Dec 05, service members in AIT must reside in the barracks until completion of the 20<sup>th</sup> week of training. Week 21 through completion (Phase V+ Soldiers) may be granted privileges approximate to those held by permanent party Soldiers.
- c. IAW Joint Federal Travel Regulation, Change 230, dated 1 Feb 06, household goods (HHG) transportation authorization does not exist for members under orders to a course of instruction (AIT) of less than 20 weeks duration except HHG within the TDY weight allowance may be transported (400 lbs.)
